



**Notice of the Referendum Vote for Local 2118
Terminate Allegiant Air Representational Assessment**

All Teamsters Local 2118 members are hereby notified that Local 2118 will be conducting a referendum vote to determine whether to terminate the Allegiant Air Representation Assessment adopted in November 2018 ("the Assessment"). (attached)

The Assessment is in the amount of .75 of 1% (.0075) of the gross earnings of each Allegiant Air Pilot. It was adopted for the purpose of covering expenses incurred on representation activities performed for the benefit of the Allegiant Air Pilots, including, but not limited to, contract negotiations to amend the current CBA, legal fees associated with grievance administration or arbitration hearings, and activities required to uphold the CBA.

At this time, the Assessment is, in my view, no longer necessary, because the Local has sufficient funds to perform its representational activities. As Temporary Trustee, I advocate for ending the Assessment.

Teamsters Local 2118 will be conducting this vote-by-mail referendum balloting. Ballots will be mailed to all eligible members on or about May 24, 2024. All ballots must be received at the designated Post Office Box by 10:30 a.m. PT on June 25, 2024. Members who have not received a ballot by June 7, 2024, should contact the Local:
