Allegiant pilots,

As you have heard, on Wednesday, the U.S. District Court for the District of Nevada enjoined our union from engaging in a strike against Allegiant. The Court determined that our dispute with Allegiant was a minor dispute under the Railway Labor Act not a major dispute. Thus, the Court enjoined us from striking.

Per the Court's Order, we are providing you with this notice of the Court's order and its contents. Under the Court's Order:

All Pilots employed by Allegiant must refrain from engaging in any self-help or going on strike against Allegiant over any dispute relating to Sections 11.3.1.4.C.24 and 11.3.1.5.C.13 of Allegiant's GOM.
